

Report from 5^{th} World Congress of Asian Federation of Psychiatrics Associations

The president Shigenobu Kanba

I am very happy to report that the 5th World Congress of Asian Psychiatry (WCAP) was held with great success. The scientific level of the congress was very high, and the attendees included nearly 500 psychiatrists from 38 countries.

The program consisted of an Asian Federation of Psychiatric Associations (AFPA) President Lecture by Professor Pichet Udomratn, a Congress President Lecture by Professor Shigenobu Kanba, an AFPA Memorial Lecture by Professor Emeritus Naotaka Shinfuku, a Keynote Lecture by AFPA council member Norman Sartorius, and a Plenary Lecture by World Psychiatric Association (WPA) President-Dinesh Bhugra. In addition, the program included 13 Special Lectures, five "Meet the Experts" sessions, and the following four Joint Workshops: AFPA/World Association for Psychosocial Rehabilitation (WAPR) (Muhammad Afzal Javed, Tae Yeon Hwang, Tadashi Takeshima), AFPA/Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Psychiatrists (RANZCP) (Stephan Macfarlane, Victor Storm), AFPA/WPA/ Japan Young Psychiatrists Organization (JYPO) (Dinesh Bhugra, Keiichiro Nishida, Hironori Kuga), and AFPA/ European Psychiatric Association (EPA) (Wolfgang Gaebel).

In addition, four workshops and 37 symposia were held, and 42 oral and 53 poster presentation were given.

The Japanese Society of Psychiatry and Neurology (JSPN) organized a successful Roundtable Discussion involving 24 presidents of AFPA member societies and other important partners, including the African Association of Psychiatrists and Allied Professions (AAPAP) (Professor Solomon Rataemane), the EPA (Professor Wolfgang Gaebel), the American Psychiatric Association (APA) (Professor Allan Tasman), and the WHO Collaborating Center in Mental Health Australia (Professor Helen Hermann).

I am certain that the participants had a good time both in and out of the congress and enjoyed all the good food that Fukuoka has to offer. Meeting good friends, both old and new, at the congress allowed us to deepen our knowledge of psychiatry and gain a better understanding of mental health in each country. At the conclusion of the congress, it was clear that AFAP members had become strongly united.




